THE CHAMPAGNE AND YOU












Welcome in Champagne area

The AOC Champagne production area is spread over five departments (Marne, Aube, Aisne, Haute-Marne and Seine-et-Marne) in the East of France in 319 cities, representing 34 200 hectares.

The grape harvest is a key step in the production of the Champagne. It's the end of the work done in the vineyard over the year and the start of the process of producing Champagne wine in cellars. In Champagne the harvest is done exclusively by hand in order not to damage the grapes and also to be able to select only ripe grapes, which gives it its exceptional character.

Your role is really important in this key stage!

We need 1.2 kg of grapes to produce a bottle of Champagne. There are 3 major grape varieties in champagne: Pinot Noir Chardonnay Pinot Meunier Chardonnay Chardonnay



PREPARING YOUR ARRIVAL TO WM PRESTA









YOU JOIN WM PRESTA AS A SEASONAL WORKER

As a service provider concerned about the well-being of its employees and respectful of current regulations, the company is engaged for many years in approaches that respect the working and living conditions of our employees

We are also listed on the platform viriances created by the key local institutions of the champagne area (the Champagne Committee, General Union of Winegrowers and the Union of Champagne Houses) as a Champagne Service Provider respecting regulations and having good practices.



WM Presta provides a several number of guarantees to its employees during the grape harvest.

CONTRACT & ADMINISTRATIVE FORMS:



By working with WM Presta:

- When you arrive at the office: **you will sign a contract of employment** with WM Presta. All administrative forms relating to you hiring are made or prepared before your arrival, so we must collect a copy of your identity card / passport and information about you before your arrival in France;
- The harvest lasts +/- 12-14 days (including the weekly rest)
- You will be organized by team with a French teamleader who will be your contact and coordinator during your stay
- You must respect **all the safety instructions** given by the employer or your teamleader and those which are in this booklet
- It's important to sign the time sheet daily each day you work, otherwise you will be considered not present
- At the end of your contract: your employer will give you all the end-of-contract documents with your salary.
- We pay by bank transfer: don't forget to bring with you a copy of your bank account details. The copy of bank account details must include your first/last name, bank logo/name, and account number. You can't provide a bank account that isn't yours, which does not belong to you.

TRANSPORTATION:



- WM Presta pays all the cost of your transportation to go and back to the WM Presta office
- All the on-site travels to the vineyards are also paid by WM Presta

ACCOMODATION:



- For foreign employees or those who do not have accommodation in the area, WM
 Presta finds and pays accommodation;
- Employees hosted by WM Presta **must respect the internal regulations** of each accommodation:
- Bring your bed linen (sleeping bag and sheets) and towels

GRAPE HARVEST WITH WM PRESTA















- I respect the organization and the safety rules in the company for my security and those of my colleagues
- I follow the instructions of my teamleader about the work to be done and I respect the instructions for sorting the grapes if there are any.



I respect the traffic laws during my shifting



I do not drive the tractor or car if I am not authorized

BEFORE WORKDAY



I take a nice and large breakfast.



I wear stable and closed shoes, and adapted clothes (no float clothes). I don't wear any jewelry.



I protect myself from the sun (hat, long and light clothes, solar protections) and i often drink water during the day.



Every morning before leaving my accommodation, I fill my water bottle given by WM Presta and I often drink water during the day if it's very hot.

WM Presta provides to everybody:

- a hat and t-shirt for your well-being, comfort and health
- a personal water bottle to fill everyday in order to limit the use of plastic bottles



WHAT YOU HAVE TO KNOW ABOUT TAP WATER

- **Tap water** in France is **drinkable**. Its quality is checked very regularly.
- Water is the most controlled food in France.



SAFETY RULES











PREVENTION & VIGILANCE

You must respect the safety rules and prevention measures describes in this booklet and/or instructions given by your teamleader/manager.

For you and people of your team: be aware of any signs of sunstroke, heat stroke (fever, rapid breathing, headache, nausea, confusion/strange behavior, etc.).

→ In case of signs or symptoms, inform immediately your teamleader.



IN CASE OF HEAT:

- Drink a lot of water
- Protect yourself from the sun
- Wear the WM hat



IN CASE OF STORM:

- Outside:
 - never go under a tree
 - crouch down and stay at least 3 meters away from other people
- If you can: move inside a building or a closed and stationary car



IN CASE OF INSECT BITES:

- Make sure you don't have an allergic reaction
- Inform your teamleader

RULES IN CASE OF ACCIDENT

- I contact my teamleader
- → It is really important to know where the first aid kit is : the first aid kit is in the car of your French teamleader.

WORK WITH EXTREME HEAT

Protect yourself





Drink a lot even if you don't be thirsty



Wear loose clothing and protect your skin and head





Be aware of any signs of sunstroke, heat stroke Fever, rapid breathing, headache, confusion / strange behavior: it's vital emergency



Reduce excessive physical effort Use handling aids



Adapt the working time



In case of emergency, call the safety teamleader (SST) and emergency 18, 15, 112

For you and your team members:

Be aware of signs of sunstroke, heat stroke (fever, rapid breathing, headache, nausea, confusion/strange behavior, etc.).

→ In case of symptoms and signs, inform right now your teamleader

WHILE TRAVELLING



IN A VEHICULE

- Close the doors properly
- Keep the shears in their case
- Sit down
- Watch out for traffic when you get off the bus



- Walk on the roadside
- Make yourself visible when it's dark

WHILE PICKING





- Wearing gloves is compulsory
- Only use the shears provided by WM Presta
- Wear good shoes and workwear appropriate to the weather



- The ground is uneven, be careful where you put your feet and wear shoes with good soles
- Pay attention to the mooring pegs at the end of the rows



- Do not work facing each other in order to avoid cuts and eyes injuries
- Take care of your back by varying your posture (squatting, legs bent)



- Not overload the harvest buckets and boxes
- Pay attention to vehicles and machines: move aside when the tractors are maneuvering
- There are lots of mosquitoes; make sure you use insect repellent. Watch out for wasps.





- If it's very hot, drink lot of water!
- Protect yourself from the sun (hat, clothes that cover you, sun cream, etc.)



PERSONAL PROTECTION



Gloves are provided for carriers, ask your teamleader. Wearing gloves is compulsory



Wear the yellow vest at your disposal to identify yourself in the vineyrad



The ground is uneven, be careful where you put your feet We will provide you with safety shoes, which you must wear



There are lots of mosquitoes make sure you use insect repellent! Watch out for wasps



If it's very hot, drink plenty of water and protect yourself from the sun (clothes that cover you, sun cream, hat given by WM Presta, etc)

CHECKING EQUIPMENT

- Check the wheelbarrow is in good condition before you use it.
- If the equipment is faulty, contact your team leader.

MOVING THE CRATES (EMPTY AND FULL)

- Don't put more than 3 crates on the wheelbarrow
- Never pull a wheelbarrow when one or more crates are full
- Don't run downhill
- Watch out for the mooring pegs
- Get help with unloading the 3rd crate
- Never lift a full crate on your own

FIRST AID KIT

The first aid kit (the red bag) is in the car of the WM Presta teamleader. It contains:

- Disinfectant
- Sterile compresses
- Dressings
- Band-aid
- Scissors
- Physiological serum
- Mist bottle
- Blanket
- Sunscreen
- Storage bag
- Sugars



Your teamleader also has an Aspivenin pump against insect bites and a tick remover. Ask for it if necessary.

Be careful when using these products in case of allergies.
